77.01 Operation of Golf Carts Permitted 77.02 Prohibited Streets

77.03 Hours 77.04 Equipment

- **77.01 OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS PERMITTED.** Golf carts may be operated upon the streets of the City by persons possessing a valid driver's license, if all of the conditions of this chapter are met.
- **77.02 PROHIBITED STREETS.** Golf carts shall not be operated upon any City street that is a primary road extension through the City. However, golf carts may cross such a primary road extension. Primary road extensions include (but are not limited to) south of the intersection of Heritage Avenue and Jeppeson Road, Highway 71 and Highway 86.
- **77.03 HOURS.** Golf carts shall only be operated on the City streets beginning one-half hour after sunrise to one-half hour before sunset, from April 1 to October 31.
- **77.04 EQUIPMENT.** Golf carts operated upon City streets shall be equipped with adequate brakes and shall meet other safety requirements imposed by the City, including (but not limited to) the following:
 - 1. Golf cart shall be equipped with a slow-moving vehicle sign and a bicycle safety flag.
 - 2. Golf carts must be operated at a speed of 10 miles per hour or less.
 - 3. No passengers shall be allowed in any towed trailer.
 - 4. If stopped by law enforcement, operator must be able to provide a valid driver's license.
 - 5. Operator must have proof of insurance.
 - 6. Operator will indemnify and hold the City harmless from any litigation.
