## CITY OF WEST OKOBOJI REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING 501 TERRACE PARK BLVD MONDAY, April 10, 2023 6:30 P.M.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, Mayor Miner called the meeting to order at 6:31 P.M. Powers/Olson moved to adopt the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried. Paxton/Hein moved to approve the treasurer's report, which included minutes of the previous meetings 3/13/23, 3/22/23 and 3/31/23, the claims report for April 2023 and the Bank Cash Report for March 2023. All ayes. Motion carried.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING**

Council to conduct public hearing regarding Resolution 2023-14. A Resolution Approving the City's Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024. Mayor Miner opened the public hearing at 6:35pm. City Administrator Miner began the hearing by explaining the budget increases/decreases from the previous year. Miner went on to explain that the finance committee went through the budget line by line and moved money into appropriate funds for normal operating expenses. There were increases to the Capital Projects, Community Beautification, Other Public Safety, and Parks funds. These increases are to pay for the upcoming projects such as the Terrace Park Beach Project and the Okoboji Blvd Water Main Project. A resident asked about the significant increase in revenue on the 'intergovernmental' line of the budget. City Administrator Miner informed the resident that the increase was due to Federal and Local Grants the city intends on receiving. Mayor Miner closed the public hearing at 6:52pm. Olson/Paxton motioned to approve the city's proposed FY 2023-2024 budget. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Council to review bids for a new water meter reader. Public Works Director Chad Wellendorf informed the council that the water meter reader the city currently has is out of date and is being phased out of production. Which means that within the next year or two the city will no longer be able purchase water meters compatible with our reader. Wellendorf answered all questions from the council regarding the bids. Powers/Hein motioned to accept the bid from Metering & Technology in the amount of \$126,775. All ayes. Motion carried.

Council to review bids for a new lawnmower. Public Works Director Chad Wellendorf informed the council that the mower the city has is starting to lose power and is having minor mechanical issues. Wellendorf answered all questions the council had regarding the bids. Olson/Powers motioned to accept the bid from Galen's Pro Mow in the amount of \$22,528. All ayes. Motion carried.

### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Steve Hallgren updated the council on the status of the CAT Grant and Okoboji Foundation Grant. Hallgren also gave a report of his work with the city over the past month.

Olson/Sieh moved to adjourn. All ayes. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:33 P.M.
