Thank you for all that have switched out your radio head on your meter. **If you would like to monitor it yourself, you can go to www.eyeonwater.com and all you need to have is your account number (that is on your bill) and zip code.** You will see 24-hour detail of your water usage and how many gallons you use. There is also an app that you can download too.

END USER FEE INCREASING

Due to Milford Municipal Utilities (MMU) upgrading their water treatment plant, our end user fee (previously invasive species fee) will be increasing on this bill, from \$29.30 (\$87.90 qtr.) per month to \$49.52 per month (\$148.56 qtr.) This is following the increase MMU is charging West Okobojo for water purchase.

KEEPING FIRE HYDRANTS CLEAR

During normal snow removal operations performed by the city crew, hydrants do become buried. When this occurs, the city crew must go out several times during the winter to uncover them. In the event of a fire, valuable time could be lost trying to locate a buried hydrant. The city is asking that you contact your snow removal service and advise them to please care and not cover a hydrant at your location. Thank you in advance for your cooperation on this matter!

PERMITS ZONING ORDINANCE

If you plan to build (including fences, decks and sheds), change the footprint of your buildings, landscape, install or replace signage, watermain taps or sell anything in town a permit must be issued from the zoning administrator first. Permits are available on the website or stop into City Hall and pick one up. Regulations are posted under Zoning Rules on the website for your reference. If you have any questions, please contact Carol at City Hall. Fines double if works starts before approval.

DUMPING OF SNOW ON CITY STREETS

Chapter 135 Section 12 of the West Okobojo Code States: It is **unlawful** for any person to throw, push, or place or cause to be thrown, pushed or placed, any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveway onto the traveled way of a street or alley so as to obstruct storm sewer drains, or impede the passage of vehicles upon the street or alley or to create a hazardous condition therein; except where, in the cleaning of large commercial drives in the business district it is absolutely necessary to move the snow onto the street or alley temporarily, such accumulation shall be moved promptly by the property owner or agent. Arrangements for the prompt removal of such accumulations shall be made prior to moving the snow. Any person violating this Code of Ordinances may be subject to a fine.

If there is an issue in your neighborhood or with your property, the City will try to call first to contact you. If you have changed your number since you have started services and have not called City Hall please reach out and update 😊

GATE AT CITY HALL

Reminder: If you are a resident and would like the access to garbage/recycling bins, you can purchase a key fob from City Hall. You can come into City Hall and purchase a fob at your convenience M-F 8am-3:30pm (closed for lunch) **These fobs are for West Okobojo Residents ONLY.** Violators fobs will be deactivated and lose privileges. If you lose your fob there will be a \$5 re-programming charge and the old fob will be deactivated.
